

MINUTES OF THE PLEASANT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR MEETING
FEBRUARY 18, 2010
4:30 PM

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 PM by Chairman Moellendick with all Trustees present. Minutes from the February 4 meeting were approved as submitted.

ODOT is requesting agreements be returned by March 26 to participate in the 2010-2011 cooperative salt purchasing program. Information on a re-submittal for a zoning variance was received from Regional Planning. Trustee comments must be received by March 19. The location of public records training has been changed from Olivedale to Liberty Center. The Fiscal Officer left a message for Attorney Edward Kim inquiring on the status of a promised letter summarizing Mr. Kim's opinion regarding Nathan Bromen's vacation request.

Mr. Bowman reported no permits issued since the last meeting. Mr. Bowman has prepared an information packet to give Zoning and BZA members at the February 25 meeting. The packet includes a meeting attendance form plus information on the definition of a business and a sample noise ordinance. Mr. Bowman discussed the SR 37 variance re-submittal with Trustees.

Ms. Moellendick said she had been questioned by some firemen regarding disability insurance and current Township coverage was discussed. There had been some questions about individuals obtaining insurance through other companies such as AFLAC. Trustees decided that the Township would not support payroll deduction for personal insurance. Ms. Moellendick also commented on previous discussion about obtaining a plow for use by the Fire Department to clear their road and apron areas.

Chief Mathias was on a fire run and could not make the meeting.

All bills submitted were approved for payment.

Mr. Gavin moved to adjourn; seconded by Ms. Moellendick. Meeting adjourned at 5:05 PM.
