

MINUTES OF THE PLEASANT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
REGULAR MEETING  
JULY 2, 2015  
5:30 PM

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Trustee Kemmerer with Trustees Kemmerer and Horn present. Trustee Moellendick had advised that she could not attend the meeting due to a death in the family.

Minutes from the June 18 Regular meeting were approved as submitted.

The Fiscal Officer submitted a reconciled bank statement for June. Ms. Moellendick had provided notes on the June 29 DAC meeting. The botulism outbreak and contract with Lancaster were discussed. Next DAC meeting will be November 30. Correspondence received included the OTARMA Annual Report and information from the Lancaster Public Transit Agency.

The public hearing was conducted on the 2016 budget. There was no public comment.

*15-042 Mr. Horn moved to adopt the budget for 2016; seconded by Mr. Kemmerer. Voting: Horn - yes; Kemmerer - yes; Moellendick - absent. Motion passed.*

Mr. Kemmerer will file the budget with the County Auditor.

Mr. Bowman reported two permits issued for \$400. A complaint was received about 1101 Beechwood. Property owner will be given until Wednesday to mow the property. A certified letter was mailed regarding removing the non-compliant sign on SR 37. Mr. Bowman reported that Mitch Price called him about letters requiring mowing the Fremar Road properties. As of the meeting date, they have not been mowed. There was discussion about mowing 876 Marquette twice a month.

Sergeant Hendershot updated Trustees about activities involving the Sheriff's Office. This included information on the new jail, a new motorcycle patrol, Community Watch, a heroin bust and the 2016 Police & Fire Games.

Harmon received a call complaining of speeding on Carpico Drive and requested a 25 MPH sign closer to SR 37. Mr. Kemmerer commented about obtaining a speed study before posting erecting a sign. A Northwood Drive resident requested that another 25 MPH sign be posted closer to the intersection with Rainbow Drive. An existing sign will be moved closer to Rainbow. The discarded pool liner on Longwood has been removed.

Fiscal Officer Snyder will attend annual CPIM classes at Columbus State on July 16.

Mr. Kemmerer will meet with the County Engineer on July 8 for a pre-construction meeting on the Rainbow Drive culvert.

Road paving was discussed. Rick and Harmon are almost finished with scratch coating roads and will be ready for Shelly to start tar & chip work in 2 weeks. Shell will be advised of the schedule.

All bills submitted were approved for payment.

Mr. Kemmerer moved to adjourn; seconded by Mr. Horn. Meeting adjourned at 6:10 PM
