

MINUTES OF THE PLEASANT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
APRIL 21, 2016
5:30 PM

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Trustee Kemmerer with all Trustees present.

Minutes from the April 7 meeting were approved as submitted.

On April 26, there will be a public viewing of the Pleasantville Road widening project at 11:15 AM and a hearing in the Commissioners Hearing Room at 5:00 PM. The TID Board meeting will be April 25 at 8:30 AM.

BWC held a hearing on Chad Mathias' claim for continuing treatment and approved continuing treatment. Deadline for appeal is April 26. Trustees discussed and decided not to appeal.

Additional information was received from cBiz indicating that United Healthcare will not insure the Union separately) and a proposal from Anthem was included as an alternative.

Mr. Bowman reported two permits issued for \$450. A variance application was received for the 8 foot fence at 2677 Pleasant Way. Mr. Bowman provided information on Zoning fees in other Townships.

An inquiry was received about installing an access driveway to a side yard at 2246 Midway. Trustees reviewed the proposed location and verbally approved.

There was discussion about the junk car situation at 4020 Wheeling Road. Mr. Bowman said there was a problem with the Sheriff's Office representative claiming that the cars had to be processed individually and it could take several months. He had not heard of this requirement and asked for ORC references.

Assistant Chief Hutton reported on Fire Department activity. The backup generator has been serviced. ACLS class was conducted by Air Evac on April 9. There was a First Responder meeting at Fairfield Union High School April 15. There will be a Fire Incident Reporting Class on May 3-5 with Lancaster Fire. The Pleasantville Safety and Health Fair will be May 18.

The new rescue is at Cummins and the transmission has been rebuilt to repair the damage caused by the sheared flex plate bolts. Chief does not agree with accepting a rebuilt transmission in a truck with less than 1,000 miles. Discussion with Pierce and Finley is continuing. The primer on the E-One was repaired by Bader.

Lt. Miller has been placed on light duty effective April 17 due to a non-work related injury.

Harmon provided quotes for removing a tree at 1735 Stringtown Road. Mid-Ohio and Arbor Barber both quoted \$700.


16-030 *Mr. Horn moved to issue a Purchase Order for \$700 to Arbor Barber to remove a tree at 1735 Stringtown Road; seconded by Ms. Moellendick. Voting: Horn - yes; Kemmerer - yes; Moellendick - yes; Motion passed.*

Trustees discussed the 2016 road paving program. The County Engineer is OK with butt joints at the bridges. Otherwise, the bridge deck would need to be ground to avoid any additional paving thickness. The County will pay for the butt joint work. Sweeping excess stone in the subdivisions will cost \$1,600/day. Trustees believe that a power broom can be rented for a lower cost.

The road ditch has been cleaned at 2300 Stringtown. The resident at 1180 Ridge Road inquired if the Township could apply about 2 inches of asphalt at the base of his steep driveway to ease the transition and prevent his car from scraping. Harmon will look at it.

All bills submitted were approved for payment.

Mr. Kemmerer moved to adjourn; seconded by Ms. Moellendick. Meeting adjourned at 7:21 PM.
